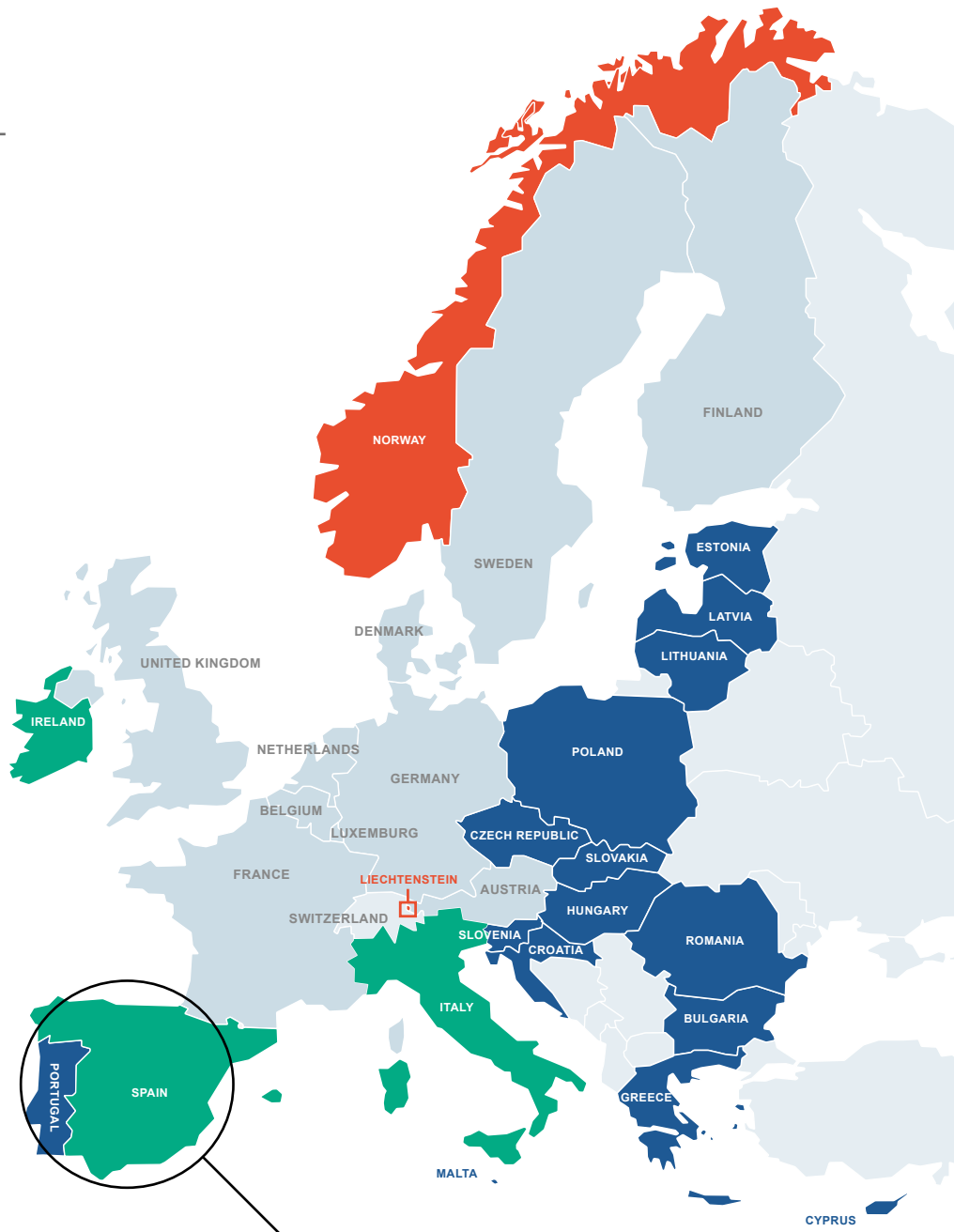

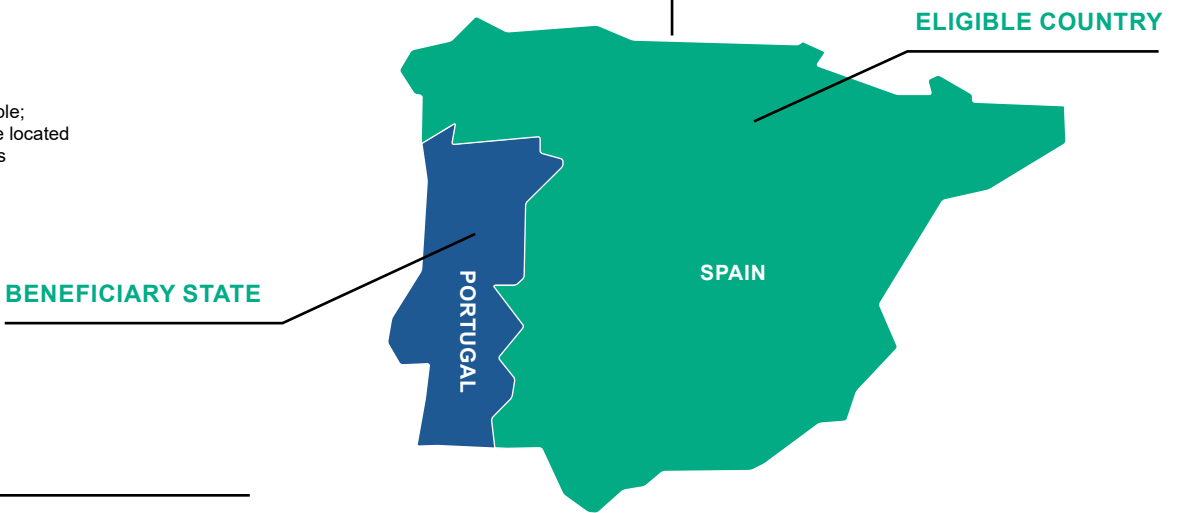


PROJECTS SHALL INVOLVE ENTITIES FROM AT LEAST TWO COUNTRIES

Regions



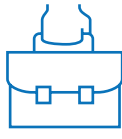
Organisational units of central government, state enterprises, state organisations

Social partners (trade unions, sector associations, employer associations, chambers of commerce and industry)

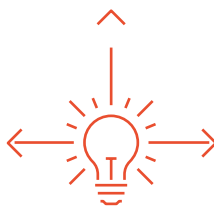
